

2021 Planning and Design Program Downtown Signals - Retiming


 Type of Work: Retiming signals in the Downtown Business

- Northtowne Road from Morse Road to Northtowne Place






2021 Planning and Design Program Bikeway Dev. – Tussing Road Shared Use Path –Brice Road to Hines Road



 Type of Work: Develop preliminary alignment for shared use path. Work could include TWLTL, lighting, and developing construction plans






2021 Planning and Design Program Bikeway Dev. – Georgesville Shared Use Path - Hall Road to Clime Rd

 Type of Work: Develop construction plans for a shared use path on east side of road








Miscellaneous - Design Manual
